COLUMBUS, Ohio, February 11 — The Ohio State University Office of Continuing Education (CEd) announces spring quarter noncredit courses in language and culture. Designed for the convenience of working adults, these courses, except English Language and American Culture\*, meet one evening per week.

- WHAT:** Language and culture courses include:
- Chinese, French, German, Italian, Japanese, and Spanish in a variety of skill levels
  - Spanish for Health Care Professionals
  - English Language and American Culture/English as a Second Language (ESL) - \*Evening classes meet two days per week, and daytime classes meet four days (Mondays – Thursdays) per week.

The new classes are:
