### **Director Retires from The Ohio State University Office of Continuing Education (CEd)**

COLUMBUS, Ohio, May 28 — After 30 years of service to The Ohio State University, Office of Continuing Education (CEd) Director Anthony T. Basil, Ph.D. (43221), will retire on June 30, 2008.

Basil earned a B.S. in Mathematics from Wheeling College, an M.A. in Mathematics from West Virginia University, and a Ph.D. in Mathematics from Catholic University.

Basil's professional career began as a mathematical programmer for NASA in 1964 and the National Security Agency from 1965–1966. His vocation in academia started when he became an associate professor (tenured) and chairman for the Department of Mathematics/Physics at Wheeling College. He also served as the director of Continuing Education, director of Summer School, and the assistant dean and director of the Evening Division. At The Ohio State University, he was an adjunct associate professor and assistant director and director for the Department of Credit Programs within the Office of Continuing Education before becoming director of CEd in its entirety.
